The Academy programmes for sending young scientists aboard are generously supported by the North American Bangladesh Islamic Community (NABIC) for participation in different international events like Lindau Nobel Laureates meeting in Germany and HOPE Nobel Laureates meeting in Japan, ACM-ICPC World Competition, Meeting of the Young Champions under the auspices of the World Science Forum etc.

I hope the BAS Newsletter will keep the Fellows of the Academy updated about different programmes and activities of the Academy and related national and international events.

- vi. The Fellows should be given a permanent Fellow Number and Identity Cards should be given to all the Fellows of the Academy.

UPCOMING EVENTS

I. IAP General Assembly and Health Conference, 25-29 September 2016, Beijing, China

InterAcademy Partnership for Health Conference on Promoting Health & General Assembly will be organized by the Chinese Academy of Engineering (CAE), Beijing, China during 25 - 29 September 2016.

The upcoming IAP for Health Conference and General Assembly will be hosted by IAP for Health in collaboration with the Chinese Academy of Engineering and organized in collaboration with the Chinese Academy of Medical Sciences/Peking Union Medical College in September 2016. The events are generously sponsored by the China Health & Medical Development Foundation.

The opening ceremony will take place on Tuesday 27 September 2016, followed by a two-day conference on 'Promoting Health' on Tuesday 27 and Wednesday 28 September 2016. The conference will explore various topics under the theme of 'Promoting Health'. These include: social determinants of health and broad context for health promotion and disease prevention, opportunities across the lifespan, integrating prevention and population health with health care and systems. Participants delivery include distinguished scholars, presidents and leadership of national academies of science, medicine, engineering, as well as experts and health advisors from both industrialized and low and middle income countries (LMIC).

The third day (Thursday 29 September2016) will be dedicated to IAP for Health General Assembly and is a closed session for representatives member academies.

The scientific programme is currently under preparation by the Conference Committee chaired by Dr. Peggy Hamburg, Foreign Secretary of the US National Academy of Medicine (formerly IOM), and Professor Liu Depei, past Vice President of the Chinese Academy of Engineering.
